THE SOWING OF THE WORD

The Bible is spiritual seed. It is sown, and produces fruit. It can be sown in nations, and should bring forth fruit in nations.

The Word of God is a seed (see Luke 8:11), and it is sown into the ground of the heart of a person. The seed of the Word springs forth, and brings much fruit. "And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come." (Matthew 4:26–29).

The Word has been sown in the Earth by God. Therefore, there must be fruits in the Earth. This is the harvest. There should be a harvest both individually and in a community.

The Bible cannot be sown and it bring forth no fruits. The English Bible has been sown in certain nations, so the fruits of it must come forth. Australia, for example, has had the Word sown in it since the beginning, and yet, Australia has NEVER experienced any national or even notable revival of religion. The evangelistic meetings of the year 1959, according to Ken Ham, were the closest that Australia ever came to any kind of revival of religion. Yet, he goes on to show how this failed. Those who have tried to convert Australia in recent years have been failing, because they have not been operating consistently with the principle of the seed of the Word. "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void" (Isaiah 55:11a). This sets down a promise: if the Word of God has been and is being sown in Australia, then there must be a reaping in Australia.

Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations" — this must include Australia — "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19a, 20a). It can come to the point where the whole nation is observing to do (obeying) Christ's Word. The incorrupt Word is available in Australia, which is a sign from God to show that there should be a great harvest in Australia. Jesus said to teach the people to follow His exact words. If Christians are trying to evangelise by using Bibles that do not exactly match with Christ's words, then there is a great problem. The solution is to use the English Bible which has been present in the nation since the beginning, and which is demonstratively accurate, and was not made by people who thought that God's words were even a little bit lost. It is evident that the Holy Ghost's revival is with the King James Bible.
