WAR ON TRUTH

There is a direct conflict taking place between truth and error, which is warring for the hearts of men, to either think one way or the other.

There is a war being waged on truth. The enemy has the objective, that at all costs, people must be kept from properly knowing the Bible.

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15).

Yet, there are many documentaries being shown which deliberately and actively come against the truth. They continuously disregard or belittle the Bible. In fact, some of the worst documentaries are made by religious people.

There are some people who pride themselves on knowing things, especially in supporting lies and errors, because they saw these things in a documentary.

Believers must recognise that the only way to defeat the enemy is to grow in proper knowledge. That means disconnecting our minds from worldly wisdom, and connecting to God by sermons and good books and Bible studies.

"The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding." (Proverbs 9:10).
